CHATELS: The above, who made his declaration to the Custodian on April 11/42, declared chattels at Semlin Drive and 6th Ave., Vancouver. On Sept. 9/46 he arranged with Mr. H. M. Drost to ship certain articles to him, and give the balance to Mrs. Wilson. We have approved this arrangement.

He also declared chattels at 1532 E. 13th Ave. Our field staff were unable to find these goods and NEGORO was notified on Jan. 4/43 that we assumed he had made other disposition of his chattels at said address. He did not reply so our assumption was apparently correct.

The file reveals the above owned no specified articles.

ACCOUNTS RECEIVABLE: The account of the above was credited with the sum of \$5.00 being a refund of security deposit for light from the B.C.E.R.

My father, Mr. Katunosuke Negoro, (Reg. No. 11233) has asked me to write this letter regarding his goods which are stored at the home of Mrs. H. C. Wilson, 2146 Semlin Drive, Vancouver, B. C.

As my father feels that the above goods would bring very little if sold at a public auction, and in view of many favors and of the trouble incurred by our kind friends, the Wilsons, he has decided to present to them all goods that have been stored there, with the exception of a few items which he is asking Mrs. Wilson to forward to him at once.
