PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

Re: Mr. Tsugio IWASAKI - #04257  
(Formerly P/W A-231)

Fishing Vessel: On March 10th, 1942, the vessel "Rock Point", owned by this Evacuee, was sold to the Canadian Fishing Company Limited. (See Supplementary Summary attached hereto).

Life Insurance: In his JP form dated April 11th, 1942, Iwasaki declared that he had a Sun Life Assurance Company policy for \$1000.00 in his possession, beneficiary being his father, Tomejiro.

The cash surrender value of the above policy, namely \$391.64, was sent to us by the Sun Life Assurance Company on July 17, 1945, which we in turn forwarded to Mr. Iwasaki on July 18th, 1945.

Bank Account: Under date of August 1st, 1942 the Bank of Montreal advised that Tsugio Iwasaki and his mother, Yasuye Iwasaki, had \$103.85 standing to the credit of a joint account in their names. In August 1942 two withdrawals in the amounts of \$25.00 and \$50.00 were made, both being paid to the mother, as per Tsugio Iwasaki's instructions.

On February 1st, 1943, the above Evacuee was informed that the Custodian had no further interest in the bank account, and that he was free, as was his mother, to make withdrawals of any remaining amount therein.

On telephoning the Bank of Montreal (Main & Hastings St. Branch) earlier this month it was confirmed that there now remains no account in the names of Yasuye Iwasaki and Tsugio Iwasaki.

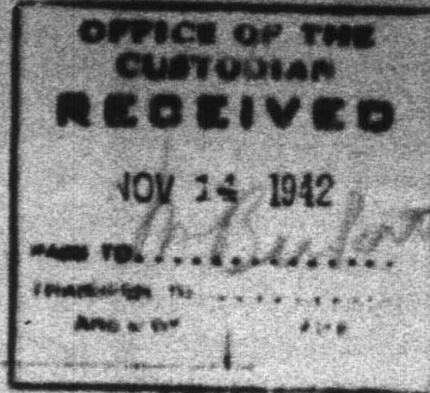

Re: Sun Life Policy No. 2,086,632

Following your arrival in Gravel, Ontario, the Custodian's file covering your affairs has been transferred to this department.

Upon reviewing your file we find that the Sun Life Assurance Company Policy No. 2,086,632 in your name, being a twenty-five year endowment policy for \$1,000.00, is held apparently by your father, Mr. Tomejiro Iwasaki, and continues to be held by your father in accordance with your wishes. It is our understanding that annual premium amounts to approximately \$35.80.

We are attaching last notice received by this office calling for payment of said amount to which you will no doubt wish to give your attention. By an arrangement made by the Custodian with the Canadian Life Officers' Association policies of this nature are held in suspense and premiums accumulate, but under the Regulation such policies are not cancelled. Our records indicate that the approximate cash value of your policy is \$360.94 and that the approximate cancellation date under automatic non-forfeiture is October, 1952.

The policy is in the hands of your father, you are now gainfully employed and we send you this letter purely as you will no doubt wish to take steps to arrange for payment of the amount due to the Sun Life Assurance Company, not only in your own interests but in the interests of your father who is beneficiary.

On October 2nd, 1942 we were informed that you had an account in the Main and Hastings branch of the Bank of Montreal, Vancouver, showing a balance at that time to the credit of you and your mother jointly of \$28.85. The Custodian has no further interest in said bank account and you are free, or your mother is free, to make withdrawals of any remaining amount therein.
