

PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

Chattels:

On April 11, 1942, this Evacuee declared in his "JP" form that he had one bed stored at 325 W. 4th Avenue, Vancouver, B. C. No trace of the disposal of this bed is revealed on this file, but on his mother's declaration form is listed a bed and spring, among other household goods at the same address which were disposed of by the Evacuees themselves. It is presumed that both declarations relate to the same bed.

Bonds:

Declared - 1 - \$50.00 Victory Bond.
This Bond was cashed by the above Evacuee prior to his internment on May 12th, 1942.


Declared - 12 - \$5.00 War Savings Certificates.
At the request of the Evacuee these Certificates were cashed, the net amount being \$48.38. A cheque for \$25.00 was forwarded to the above Evacuee on October 1, 1942 for the purchase of personal articles for daily use; a further cheque for \$13.38 was sent on November 30th, 1942 and the balance of \$10.00 on December 11, 1942.

Life Insurance: In his "JP" form the above Evacuee declared a \$500.00 Sun Life Insurance Policy (Beneficiary - mother). A further declaration was made by Iwasaki at Petawawa Internment Camp which revealed that the Policy was for \$1000.00. This is confirmed by "Form D" on file, sent to us by the Sun Life Insurance Company. On August 11th, 1942 the Sun Life wrote stating that the above policy had been cancelled because of non-payment of the second year's premium, due on May 21st, 1942.

No evidence is shown on file that this policy was reinstated.

No other personal property of the above Japanese person is revealed on this file.

MEMORANDUM

(Internment No. J.422)

The above named Japanese was arrested on May 13th, 1942 for failing to leave the Defence Area when instructed to do so. He had instructions to leave the area on April 13th, 1942 for Three Valley, B. C. When questioned he stated he did not wish to leave the area for a work camp or other project and would rather be interned. He stated he had no intention of co-operating with the authorities in the present evacuation.

He was handed over to the Military Guard at the Canadian Immigration Building.

The above Japanese was released from Internment Camp on April 19th, 1943 on the authority of the R. C. M. P. He was released conditionally upon his subscribing to a Special Undertaking.
