GENERAL SUMMARY

August 13, 1946.

Re: Jack Shigeo TAKAYESU, #11976

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 11, 1942. He was evacuated on April 13, 1942.

In his declaration he reported a 1941 General Electric radio left with George Eden at Ocean Falls. We were unable to locate either George Eden or the radio, Eden having moved from Ocean Falls about the end of March, 1942, according to police report.

He reported twelve \$5.00 War Savings Certificates and a \$100.00 Victory Bond in his own possession. These did not come under the control of this office.

We are endeavouring to locate the above noted in order to ascertain the whereabouts of a radio which a Japanese by the name of Jack (Shigeo) Takayesu has declared to be in Mr. Eden's possession.

(1) With reference to the letter from Inspector R. Peachey, i/c C.I.B., B.C. Police, addressed to the Officer Commanding "D" Division, Prince Rupert, B. C. I have to report that George Eden left Ocean Falls about the end of March 1942.

(2) I have made enquiries here, and find that he did not leave any forwarding address, but Dr. W. S. Kergin, resident physician, informs me that he told him just before he left that he intended to go to New Westminster or Chilliwack where he was hoping to obtain work with the Provincial Government Road Service, so The Department of Public Works may have some information regarding his present whereabouts. Dr. Kergin informed me that he was aware that Eden had a radio in the Orderly Room at the Ocean Falls Hospital, but he does not remember the type or make of same, and he is sure that when Eden left Ocean Falls, he took the radio with him. 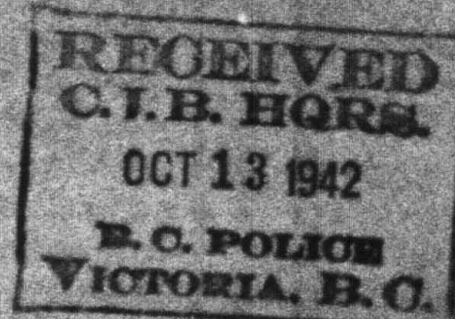
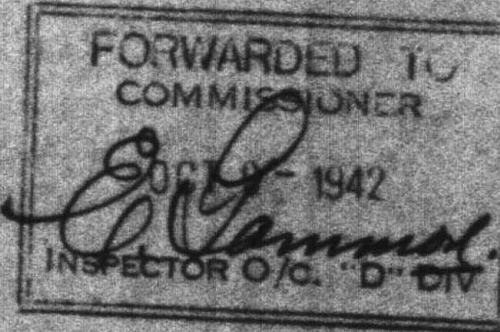
