GENERAL SUMMARY

August 14, 1946.

Re: Shiro MATSUMOTO, Reg. No. 07727

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 11, 1942. He was evacuated on October 26, 1942.

In his declaration he reported a gas boat in custody at New Westminster. The records of the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee show that this vessel was sold and the net proceeds of \$304.40 were paid to MATSUMOTO on August 13, 1943.

The Prudential Life Insurance Co. notified us that this man had a policy with that company and had applied for cash surrender value. This file does not show whether this surrender was allowed or not.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.
