Re: Estate of Goyo NISHI, Deceased.
Registration No. 01716.

Since writing to you on January 10, 1946, as you are aware, the matter of chattels belonging to your mother and the rest of the family has been adjusted, with the result that a credit of \$110.65 is at present in your mother's account. As far as this office is aware, and as indicated by you on the Memorandum of Particulars form, no assets other than chattels were left by her in the Protected Area of British Columbia.

On January 19, 1946, we received, from the Department of Labour, a claim for recovery of the sum of \$80.00 from the Estate of your mother to cover the cost of her funeral which was paid by the Department. It is requested that sufficient funds be deducted from her account to satisfy this claim and we are sure that it will be in order for this bill to be paid through this office. This will leave a balance of \$30.65, disposition of which will have to be made.

Furthermore, the Memorandum of Particulars form which you completed indicates the existence of a Prudential Life Insurance Policy but there is no information as to the amount or beneficiary. If there is a beneficiary named in the policy, the Insurance Company will require a release from Succession Duties, but the benefits will be payable to the beneficiary named.

As far as the \$30.65 is concerned, unless the matter of your mother's estate has already been referred to a Solicitor or Official Administrator as suggested in our letter of January 10, we think, since the amount is so small, it would be desirable for your family to arrange among yourselves to whom you wish the money paid. Since one of your sisters is, apparently, too young to be able to relinquish her interest, we might suggest that the rest of you, who are capable, sign a relinquishment in her favour. It would be sufficient, as far as this office is concerned, if a letter, signed by the surviving members of your family, is written requesting that this money be paid to your sister, Sacho.
