GENERAL SUMMARY

Re: Shinichi ITO, Reg. No. 97174

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 11, 1942. He was evacuated on April 13, 1942. On May 31, 1946, he was repatriated to Japan.

In his declaration, ITO stated that he owned a trunk of clothing in the care of Mr. YAMAMURA, 1529 3rd Avenue. Neither Mr. or Mrs. YAMAMURA, of that address (Files 11339 and 9735) reported any chattels and we have no record of chattels being found at their former residence. It is assumed that this trunk was taken away by ITO or otherwise disposed of.

ITO reported no other property of any kind and none identified by us as his has been found by this office.

The Vancouver General Hospital on April 21, 1942 filed claim for \$76.40 against ITO. This office has no record of the payment of this claim.

At the time of his repatriation ITO turned in to this office a copy of his 1945 Income Tax Return, which showed an overpayment of \$38.57. This appears to have been in error, as we have received from the Department of National Revenue a claim of \$1.77 covering a balance of 1945 Income Tax due from Shinichi ITO. That Department has been informed that no funds stand to the credit of ITO with this office.

This summary is certified to be in accordance with information on file.


