GENERAL SUMMARY

This 31-year old Canadian-born Millworker from Ocean Falls, B. C., signed a Custodian "JP" declaration form on the 11th April, 1942. He was single at the time he was evacuated (Apr. 13/42).

The following is a summary of the contents of this file as disclosed by a review made today.

Bonds, Shares, etc.: War Savings Certificates (10 @ \$5.00) declared to be in owner's possession, did not come under the administration of this office.

On June 7/43 the Company sent in to this office their cheque (for \$16.98) representing Cash Surrender Value of this policy, which we re-forwarded (June 9/43) to evacuee.
