CHATELS:

The above, who made his declaration to the Custodian on April 11/42, and was evacuated on April 13/42, declared one box of tools and three cross cut saws at 205 Gore Ave., Vancouver. We wrote to the occupier of this address on April 20/42 asking if he had these goods stored there. S. YAMASHITA, the proprietor of this address, replied that he knew nothing about these goods. On Oct. 10/42 we wrote to the above and asked him about these chattels and he advised us on Nov. 27/42 that he had left no chattels at his former address at 205 Gore Ave. The Department of Labour on April 2nd, 1946, supplied us with a list of personal articles found in the possession of the above at the time of his death. As they are of very little value, we are advising the Department to sell these articles in Slocan and to apply the proceeds of sale against the funeral expenses. We are also asking the Dept. to let us know the amount of proceeds of sale for our records.

Account in the name of the above to the value of fifty five cents is being closed and we are remitting this small balance to the Dept. to be applied against the funeral expenses of the above.

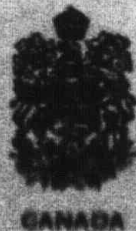
