PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

Re: Koji TASAKA, Reg.No.07892

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 14, 1942. He was evacuated on May 12, 1942.

In his declaration he reported ownership of a kitchen stove, dishes, furniture and piano, a rug and bookcase, 3 beds and clothing. All these it would seem were at 167 1/2 West 1st, the address at which TASAKA had lived and conducted a Japanese Language School. However, the only goods belonging to this man shown by our records as having been under the control of the Custodian is a piano. The piano was sold for the net sum of \$70.00. Possibly the remainder of the goods reported by TASAKA were disposed of in some manner by himself prior to evacuation.

One trunk and one box of goods shipped by J. Tasaka, Claxton (File 1484) to Koji Tasaka were released to the consignee on April 27, 1942. These men are brothers. Nothing further appears on file about these items.

TASAKA reported a policy with the Sun Life Assurance Co. of Canada. This was not brought under the control of this office.

The camera referred to in this file was the property of Tsusaburo TAKAHASHI, File 14549, and is dealt with in that file.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.
