Files 2975 and 3815 show a number of claims, as follows:

1. Armstrong Brothers Shipyard - \$85.00 for work on a boat with a Buffalo engine. The MV "Kongo" declared by both Chonosuke NISHIMOTO, File 2975 and by Kazuo NISHIMOTO, File 2969, had a Buffalo engine. For some reason this claim was not referred to Kazuo NISHIMOTO.
2. Dr. R. L. Miller - \$218.00 (Approximately \$200.00 of this claim covers treatment in connection with the illness of the deceased father of Akio and Kazuo NISHIMOTO, the remainder is against Akio alone).

Chonosuke NISHIMOTO, to whom these claims were referred, admitted that he had debts but stated that he could not pay. This might be another case of the member of the family who had no assets acknowledging liabilities of the one who had assets.

These liabilities should be called to the attention of Kazuo NISHIMOTO on the chance that he may have sufficient assets to pay off some of them.
