This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 14, 1942, and was evacuated on May 1, 1942.

SECURITIES: The only personal property declared was nine War Savings Certificates valued at \$10.00 each, in his own possession. These did not come under the control of this office.

SPECIFIED ARTICLES: The camera and radio, dealt with in Specified Articles memorandum, were reported by the Royal Canadian Mounted Police. The camera was shipped to the owner by the British Columbia Security Commission on April 27, 1943. The radio was sold by the custodian, and the net proceeds of \$26.73 credited to the owner's account.

This file reveals no evidence of ownership of any other property of any kind whatsoever.

Dear Sir:

Your letter of November 3rd, enclosing radio receipt, has been received, and, as you have requested, we are remitting to you the sum of \$26.73, representing the net proceeds from the sale of your radio.

The camera, which was surrendered by you at the same time as the radio, was released in April, 1943, to the British Columbia Security Commission for shipment to you.

The only other property belonging to you of which this office has record are nine War Savings Certificates. These were in your own possession at the time of your declaration and did not come under the control of the Custodian.

The enclosed cheque for \$26.73 represents all funds in your account with this office.

It would appear that we have accounted for all the property of every kind left by you in the protected area which vested in the Custodian, and in order that you may confirm this and acknowledge the enclosed cheque, we are attaching a stamped, addressed envelope for your convenience in replying.
