CHATTELS:

The above, who made his declaration to the Gustodian on April 13/42 and was evacuated on Sept. 9/42, declared household and personal effects including kitchen stove, table, chairs and utensils, all in his own possession at 110 Main St., Vancouver, and a boat the "Kanako" in custody of the Navy at New Westminster.

When our investigators went to this address to remove the goods, they were advised that the above had sold his chattels to the new tenant and we advised MATSUI of this in our letter of Oct. 10/43 and a sked him to confirm this. No reply was received to this letter, so we may assume the information is correct.

a letter dated Feb. 24/43 on file from Mansuke FUJIMOTO, File 408, stated that Shinzo MATSUI had not received his articles, from the Inverness Cannery. We wrote to FUJIMOTO on March 6/43 and stated that neither Shinzo MATSUI or his wife had declared any goods at the Inverness Cannery and that the Cannery stated they had no goods belonging to Japanese left in the Cannery. FUJIMOTO replied on March 11/43 and advised that he had asked to have his own goods from that Cannery sent to Mr. Shinzo MATSUI Lemon Creek and that so far Mr. MATSUI had not received them. Actually the goods of FUJIMOTO from the Inverness Cannery had been moved to the Japanese Hall at Frince Rupert under the care of Mr. G.L. Porie, and FUJIMOTO had given instructions that he wished these goods to be sent to Shinzo MATSUI at Temon Greek, who presumably was going to look after them for him. At any rate this had nothing to do with any goods belonging to the above.

SPECIFIED ARTICLES:

The vessel declared by the above was sold through the Japanese Fishing Vessel Disposal Committee for the net sum of \$254.90 and this was paid to the above on August 14/42. Full details are given on Specified Articles Summary on file.

MONEYS RECEIVABLE:

On April 11/45 the account of the above was credited with the sum of \$50.25, being payment to the above from the Canadian Government for transportation charges on his fishing vessel the "Kanako", from Steveston to Prince Supert.

WAR SAVINGS CERTIFICATES:

The above declared War Savings Certificates to the value of \$20.00 in his own possession. These did not come under the control of the Cumtodian.

LIFE Insurance:

The above declared a life insurance policy in the sum of \$1500.00 with the Manufacturers Life Insurance Co. the beneficiary being his wife Kane. This policy did not come under the control of the Custodian.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.


