GENERAL SUMMARY

Re: Otsujiro SHIGEMI - Reg. No. 13424

When registering with this office, the above Japanese declared that his truck had been turned over to the R.C.M.P., and that a debt of \$250.00 was owing on it to the Western Finance Company. The Pacific Co-operative Union sold this truck, (as agreed between the Japanese and them) for the sum of \$700.00. \$265.70 of this amount was paid by them to the Western Finance Company in full settlement of their account, and the balance was forwarded to this office to Otsujiro SHIGEMI's credit.

A claim of \$4.00 was filed against SHIGEMI by Dr. G. Morse. This was acknowledged by Otsujiro SHIGEMI and paid from his account here.

He declared a Western Mutual Benefit Association Insurance policy when registering but this was not brought under control by the Custodian.

This file reveals no other assets or liabilities, and all funds have been remitted to the Japanese. No further administration therefore is necessary, and this file may now be closed.

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.

We trust you will find both statements self-explanatory and that the figures given will agree entirely with your own records.

Your letter makes mention of your calculations indicating that the balance should be \$330.30. The difference between \$372.30 and \$330.30 is exactly \$42.00 and the item of \$42.00 doubtless refers to the credit item for the same amount granted to you by the Pacific Co-operative Union covering return of fertilizer.
