This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 13, 1942. He was evacuated on June 29, 1942.

In his declaration he reported a policy of \$500.00 with an unnamed company and a \$1,000.00 policy with the Sun Life Assurance Co., converted to a paid-up policy. These policies did not come under the control of this office.

The R.C.M.P. handed to this office a Brownie camera and a Kolster radio surrendered by this man. The camera is still on hand. The radio was sold and the net proceeds of \$7.87 credited to the account of this man.

This man sent in a copy of a Judgment dated July 22, 1932 against Genya YADA, Genichiro YADA and the Lion Lumber Co. Ltd. for \$2,808.45. This office was unable to do anything about collecting this amount.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.

We are enclosing judgment papers dated July, 1932, stating that the "court doth order and adjudge that the defendants, Genya Yada and Genichiro Yada do forthwith pay to plaintiff Mori the sum of \$2,500 with interest at 5% and plaintiff Hikida the sum of \$2,898.45 with interest at 5%.

We have tried to get the two amounts from the defendants after that date, but have failed to do so, although they had considerable properties, because at that time, they had changed the names. At present, however, we do not know in what conditions their properties are.

We should like you to take steps in getting the amounts for us by taking into consideration, also, the fact that they have life insurances of over \$10,000 in the Glown Life Insurance Company of Vancouver.

Please attend to this matter as soon as possible.

AND UPON HEARING the evidence adduced by and on behalf of the respective parties and what was alleged by Counsel aforesaid and UPON HEADING the pleadings and proceedings herein, Judgment was reserved,

AND THIS ACTION standing this day for Judgment,

THIS COURT DOTH ORDER AND ADJUDGE that the contract for the sale of 25 shares of the Capital Stock of Defendant Company to Plaintiff Sukegoro Mori by Defendant Company be and is hereby rescinded and that the Defendant Company do forthwith repay to said Plaintiff Mori the sum of \$2,500.00 paid therefor,

AND THIS COURT DOTH ORDER AND ADJUDGE that the contract for the sale of 35 shares of the Capital Stock of Defendant Company to Plaintiff Tomekichi Kikida by Defendant Company be and is hereby rescinded and that the Defendant Company do forthwith repay to said Plaintiff Hikida the sum of \$2,806.45 paid therefor,

AND THIS COURT DOTH FURTHER ORDER AND ADJUDGE that the Defendants Genya Yada and Genichiro Yada do forthwith pay to Plaintiff Mori, as damages for fraud and misrepresentation for inducing said Plaintiff Mori to enter into the said contract to purchase the shares hereinbefore

mentioned, the sum of \$2,500.00 together with interest thereon at the rate of 5% from the dates same was paid to the Defendant Company to the date hereof amounting in all to \$2,667.00.

AND THIS COURT DOTH FURTHER ORDER AND ADJUDGE that the Defendants Genya Yada and Genichiro Yada do forthwith pay to Plaintiff Hikida, as damages for fraud and misrepresentation for inducing said Plaintiff Hikida to enter into the said contract to purchase the shares hereinbefore mentioned, the sum of \$2,808.45 together with interest thereon at the rate of 5% from the dates the said sum was paid to the Defendant Company to the date hereof, amounting in all to \$2,986.32,

AND THIS COURT DOTH FURTHER ORDER AND ADJUDGE that the Plaintiffs do recover against the Defendants Lion Lumber Company Limited, Genya Yada, and Genichiro Yada their full costs of this action, except as hereinafter stated, to be paid forthwith after taxation thereof.

AND THIS COURT DOTH FURTHER ORDER AND ADJUDGE that the Plaintiffs' claim against the Defendant Genji Yada be and is hereby dismissed with costs to be taxed by the taxing officer and paid forthwith after taxation thereof.

AND THIS COURT DOTH FURTHER ORDER AND ADJUDGE that the orders for the payment of the sums and taxed costs above set out by the Defendants, Lion Lumber Company Limited, Genya Yada and Genichiro Yada shall not be cumulative so that the Plaintiff Mori shall recover under this Judgment no more than \$2,667.00 and the Plaintiff Hikida no more than \$2,986.32, together with taxed costs,

AND THIS COURT DOTH FURTHER ORDER AND ADJUDGE that in the taxation of the costs hereunder the Plaintiffs shall not be entitled to tax any costs against the Defendants or any of them for the three witnesses, Mr. Horiya, Mr. Otani and Mr. Nishikawa either for attendance thereon or for attendance at the trial.

Dear Sir:

There is a balance of \$7.87 standing to your credit with this office. This amount was received as the net proceeds from the sale of the radio surrendered by you to the Royal Canadian Mounted Police. If you will send in to this office the receipt given to you at the time this radio was surrendered this credit balance will then be considered free.

We are holding in our office a 620 Brownie Junior Box camera also surrendered by you. If you will send in the receipt given to you at the time this camera was surrendered we will deduct the cost of mailing from your credit balance with this office amounting to approximately 25 cents, and send your camera to you.

The Vancouver General Hospital filed a claim for \$11.50 against "Mr. HIKIDA" of 875 West 7th Ave., Vancouver. We referred this claim to you and your son but have received no reply.
