



INSURANCE SUMMARY

August 23rd, 1945.

Re: Noboru NAKASHIMA

The above declared on his J.P. form, a \$1000.00 Endowment Policy No. 2,203,299, carried by the Sun Life Assurance Co., Vancouver Branch, the beneficiary, his mother, Mrs. Rin NAKASHIMA. The policy was stated as being in the possession of the owner. On Dec. 19, 1942, we received a letter from the Sun Life Co. asking permission to pay direct to Noboru NAKASHIMA and Mrs. Rin NAKASHIMA, the surrender value of the policy, approximately \$164.00. On January 5th, 1943, we wrote the company and advised them that we had no objection to this money being paid direct to the owner of the policy and the beneficiary.
