
This Japanese declared on his JP Declaration April 14th, 1942, the following: Fishing nets and twines, 1 skiff, 2 hand carts, Heavy Hardwares, and 1 Grayfish Winch, stored at Phoenix Cannery House No. 39, P.O. Box 234, Steveston, B.C. See Net Statement of February 5th, 1944, for information re nets belonging to this Japanese. A memo dated August 22nd, 1945, covering the remaining chattels declared stored at the Phoenix Cannery requests the whereabouts of same but there is nothing further reported on these chattels.

A boat by the name of "T.S."/"Iris" was sold by Shimane on March 28, 1942, and proceeds paid direct to him on March 30, 1942.

There is nothing further on file in connection with chattels belonging to Taro SHIMANE.
