PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

File No. 3081

October 2, 1947.

Re: Reigo OKADA, Reg. No. 10233

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 13, 1942. He was evacuated on April 22, 1942.

CHATELS

Information on OKADA's JP Form states that OKADA was a logger in the employ of Y. SUZUKI (File 2510) Stillwater, B. C. However, OKADA had been on Compensation for 7 months and was residing in a rooming house at 433 Alexander St. Vancouver at the time of evacuation from Stillwater.

OKADA stated that he had left the following articles at Stillwater with a white man whose name he did not know:

- 1 instrument for turning logs
- 3 long 7½ ft. saws
- 1 sledge hammer
- 6 weights
- 3 sawhandles
- 1 Kodak camera (\$28.00)

He valued the goods at approximately \$100.00, and asked that the Custodian obtain and look after same for him.

The situation in regard to Stillwater at the time of the Japanese evacuation is explained in Mr. Green's memo of April 30, 1943. The Japanese at Stillwater were evacuated on very little notice and had no time to prepare their chattels for storage or removal. OKADA, being in Vancouver at the time of the evacuation, would have no chance to arrange for the safe keeping of his equipment, or obtaining it from the man with whom he had left it. As little equipment left at Stillwater has been accounted for, and as we have been advised by Mr. McNair of the McNair Shingle Company, that tools, etc. had been stolen, there is not much possibility of ever finding OKADA's equipment. Nothing further can be done about this situation unless OKADA should claim for the loss of his chattels.

BONDS

OKADA reported one \$50.00 Dominion of Canada Bond. This was not brought under the control of the Custodian.

BANK ACCOUNT

Reported an account of about \$300.00 in the Royal Bank, East End Branch. This was not brought under the control of the Custodian.

LIFE INSURANCE

Reported a May Insurance Company, Japan, Policy for 5,000 yen, in the possession of his father. This was not brought under the control of the Custodian.

This file reveals no other property.
