We are in receipt of your letter of the 15th instant and note contents.

The above-mentioned decedent declared in his 'JP' Form, signed on April 14, 1942, that he had a policy for \$2,500.00 in the Mutual Benefit Association, and named his son, Yasutaro SAKAMOTO, Registration No. 12861, as beneficiary. We have not received any advice from this Association regarding payment of the claim under said policy.

The son was the owner of property in the Municipality of Langley, same having been sold to the Director, Veterans' Land Act, and net proceeds of \$667.82 credited to his account with the Custodian. These funds were used mainly for the payment of claims and the credit balance in Mr. SAKAMOTO's account at this date only amounts to \$39.85.

We are not aware of any assets belonging to the deceased and he does not have any funds at credit in this Office.
