The above, who made his declaration to the Custodian on April 14th, 1942, and was evacuated on June 6th, 1942, declared no chattels whatsoever. However a few articles were found at 369 Powell Street and identified as belonging to the above. These were sold in Vancouver auctions Nos. 55 and 511 for the net sum of \$16.78, and this amount credited to his account. Cameras were mailed to his wife on January 15th, 1946, and the shipping charges for same, in the sum of thirty four cents, were taken from his account, leaving a balance of \$16.44 standing to his credit.
