Re: Wages due

I, with my two brothers (NISHINO, Tsutomu p/w #672; NISHINO, Takeshi p/w #671), had been working at the road camp prior to our internment to this camp.

To date I and my two brothers have not received our wages for the month of July, 1942, at which time we were working at the North Fork and Griffin Lake road camps in B. C.

Therefore I would be greatly obliged if you will kindly look into this matter as soon as possible and to forward us our cheques for the wages due us in care of this camp.
