



NISHIHAMA who may have returned to Japan prior to the outbreak of the war.

MEMORANDUM

TO: MRS. A. G. MONTGOMERY

FROM: MR. E. W. WRIGHT

RE: Gentichi NISHIMURA

We are today crediting the above named Evacuee's account with the sum of \$200.00 received from the Controller of the B.C. Fish Saltries Limited. This is an account for wages owing for 1940 shown on the Company's books in the name of Gentichi NISHIMURA of Steveston, B.C.

The Evacuee lived in Steveston but declared no claim against the Company to the Controller and his yellow card stated that he was employed by the Casler Fishing Company Limited, Skeena River prior to Evacuation.

It might be well to have this man submit proof of his right to these funds before making any disbursements.

A copy of this memo is being sent to Mr. Good.

Attached please find a requisition covering the transfer of \$200.00 from Genkichi NISHIHAMA, #02808, to G. NISHIHAMA in Japan. These funds are payment received from the B. C. Fish Salteries Limited, covering the wages and it is apparent from a letter received from Genkichi NISHIHAMA that these funds are not for his account. We are therefore opening a new account in the name of G. NISHIHAMA in Japan, as we presume that the owner of these funds may have returned to Japan prior to the outbreak of war.
