When Mr. Peters was here in Tashme, I had reported to him that I had left that I had left 440 fathoms of fishing net in care of Mr. Ono of Marpole but had failed to tell the exact address.

Your letter mentions Mr. Shohel Ono, Reg. No. 08564, of 1226 West 77th Ave., Marpole, Vancouver, B. C. This is the wrong person. I had left my nets in care of Mr. Yoshikazu Ono, Reg. No. 05841, of 1224 West 77th Ave., Marpole, Vancouver, B.C.

I might add that I had been notified previously by your office that the nets had been removed from the latter address to the Custodian's Warehouse on Powell Street. Since then, I have not received any word as to whether or not, the net had been sold.

Will you kindly check and ascertain if the net is still in the warehouse or has been sold? If sold, there should be a free balance to my credit. I wish to enquire if I may take this free balance with me to Japan, arrangements to be made at the boat at time of departure.

I will appreciate it if you will kindly check and reply at the very earliest.
