
Please note that the above has been repatriated to Japan. At the time of repatriation, the following transactions took place:

PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

File No. 3141

July 25, 1946.

RE: Kinaburo URATA, Reg. No. 05410

CHATELS: The above, who made his declaration to the Custodian on April 13/42 and was evacuated on April 28/42, stated that he had no chattels. However in a letter from him dated June 11/43 he listed the following goods left at the B.C. Fish Salteries Co., Otter Bay, where he had been foreman for the Company:

electric iron	Japanese sea weed
Japanese tea	1 garden hose

A Custodian release for shipment of these goods dated June 19/43 was received in this office. We wrote to Mr. Cousineau asking him to arrange this shipment. However Mr. Cousineau telephoned this office advising that the B.C. Fish Salteries Co. had been taken over by the London Fish Co. and we therefore wrote to them regarding this shipment. This company replied to our letter stating that they had no objection to the shipment being made and stating they would send a letter to Cousineau permitting him to release these goods for shipment. We have a letter on file from the B.C.S.C. dated Aug. 4/43 stating that Cousineau had paid \$2.35 for freight charges on a shipment sent to the above in July, 1943, and we therefore suppose the goods were shipped as requested. In this letter they also advise us that the above wrote to Mr. Cousineau and asked for shipment of a basket of blankets left in his care. We presume this shipment also went forward as we heard no further about the matter.

SPECIFIED ARTICLES: According to information supplied to this office the above was the registered owner of a fishing vessel the "K?U." which was sold through the Japanese Fishing Vessel Disposal Committee for the net sum of \$1,480.00, and this sum was paid to the above on March 30/42. Full details are given on Specified Articles Summary on file.

WAR SAVINGS CERTIFICATE: The above declared a \$5.00 War Savings Certificate in his own possession. This did not come under the control of the Custodian.

LIFE INSURANCE: The above declared an insurance policy with the Sun Life Assurance Co., in the sum of \$1000.00, the beneficiary being his wife. This policy did not come under the control of the Custodian.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.
