



PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

September 31, 1946.

Re: Naoichi ONO, Reg. No. 01042

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 13, 1942.

In his declaration he reported ownership of the vessel "Riptide". This vessel was sold, as shown in the Vessel Summary, on Bill of Sale Signed by the Custodian, as ONO had refused to sign this document. The vessel had been requisitioned by the Army and was sold at the price placed on her by Lloyd's, \$1,200.00. The Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee, who handled the sale, deducted \$17.00 to cover their supervision costs and remitted the balance of \$1,183.00 to the Custodian for crediting to the account of Naoichi ONO.

Naoichi ONO reported a bank account of \$1.50 in Royal Bank of Canada, Harpole Branch. This did not come under the control of this office.

He reported a \$2,000.00 25-year Endowment policy with the Mutual Life Insurance Co. On February 15, 1943, Yoshikasu ONO, brother and beneficiary, File No. 8007, paid through this office premium of \$42.92 on this policy. Since that time premiums have been paid, from the account of Naoichi ONO, totalling \$251.28. Premiums were paid up to September, 1946.

This file reveals no other personal property.

A remittance of \$200.00 was made to ONO on March 2, 1944. His credit balance at this time is \$731.72, which is being remitted to him.

The funds in your account were received from the sale of your vessel "Riptide". This vessel was sold for the total sum of \$1,200.00. The supervision costs of the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee were \$17.00, leaving a balance of \$1,183.00, which was credited to your account with this office.
