On April 2, 1942, this man signed a declaration to the Custodian stating that he owned no property left in the protected area.

On October 5, 1942, the Canadian Fishing Co. Ltd. reported that 2 boxes of utensils some rubber clothing, a gaff and 2 lanterns belonging to this man were at Oceanic Cannery. On August 6, 1943, Mrs. Arnold, of H. G. Helgersen's Ltd., Prince Rupert, Custodian agent, informed this office that any goods remaining at Oceanic were worthless and should be regarded as discarded.
