PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

Re: Shigemichi ASHIKAWA, Reg. No. 09062

This man signed Declaration onf APRIL 9, 1942, stating that he owned no property of any kind whatsoever in the protected area.

However the RCMP reported a radio surrendered on behalf of this man as being in their custody.

An offer to purchase the radio at price of \$20.00 was refused by the owner on September 3, 1942. He stated that he had paid \$48.00 for the radio, and had used it a short time only. His statement is not quite in accordance with the Lien Agreement filed by the vendor of the radio, David Spencer Limited. This agreement shows purchase date as November 13, 1941, and purchase price as \$35.85.

The radio was appraised in 1942 at a value of \$10.00.

The price, as shown by Specified Articles Summary, obtained in auction, was \$17.50, from which were deducted expenses of \$3.12, leaving \$14.38 net. The net proceeds were credited to the owner's account.

There is no evidence on the file of any other property of any kind.

## DAVID SPENCER LIMITED

## LIEN AGREEMENT

THIS CERTIFIES that I/we Mr. S. Ashikawa

having rented and received from DAVID SPENCER LIMITED Radio as per  
 invoice to the value of \$35.85 have this day paid DAVID SPENCER LIMITED the sum  
 of \$12.00 and further agree to pay the sum of \$          on  
 and \$ 5.00 on the 13th day of each and every month/com. December until the entire sum of  
\$35.85 Plus \$ .75 Carrying Charge plus \$          Freight, a total  
 of \$ 36.60 in all be paid.

After the expiration of this Contract April 13 19 42 I agree to pay an additional  
 Carrying Charge of \$ .15 per month on any Balance outstanding, until paid in full.

It is agreed that until the whole of the purchase money plus carrying charges be paid, the goods shall remain the property of David Spencer Limited, and in default of any payment or should the Company at any time deem any payment unsafe or insecure, the whole balance of the said purchase money shall become due, and the said David Spencer Limited or their agents may retake possession of the said goods without process of law, and at any time thereafter may sell same at public auction or by private sale, the proceeds thereof, less proper charges for retaking possession and sale, to be applied on account of the balance then unpaid, and I/we agree to pay forthwith any deficiency remaining after such sale. The Company may elect to keep the said goods after re-possession and in that event all previous payments shall be considered as rent only and forfeited to the Company.

If any goods purchased hereunder are exchanged for or substituted by other goods or if any additional goods be purchased from the Company under similar agreement then this agreement and the agreement entered into in respect of the exchanged, substituted, or additional goods shall be read together as one agreement and the indebtedness incurred in respect of this and such other agreements shall be deemed to be consolidated, and default occurring under any of them shall operate as a default under all of them, and all powers herein contained shall become exercisable.

I/we also agree that the said David Spencer Limited or their agents shall have the right to enter my/our premises at any time by force or otherwise in order to take possession of the goods herein referred to, or any part thereof, and I hereby absolutely waive my/our rights of appropriation of payments, and the said David Spencer Limited may appropriate any money hereafter received from me to the reduction of any current or other account due to the said company and distinct from the account in connection with the said goods, whether at present or hereafter existing, until the amount of such current or other account be fully paid.

The said goods shall, until paid for, be used only at Indian River

Pacific Shingle Co.

and shall not be removed therefrom without the written consent of the Company, and I/we agree to keep the said goods fully insured with loss payable to David Spencer Limited.

Dear Sir:

Enclosed herewith is Custodian cheque in the amount of \$9.78, covering all the funds standing to your credit with this office.

When you reported to the Custodian on April 9, 1942, you declared that you owned no property of any kind. The Royal Canadian Mounted Police, however, informed this office that you had surrendered a radio. This radio was sold for the sum of \$17.50. Expenses in connection with this radio amounted to \$3.12, leaving a balance of \$14.38, which was credited to your account.

David Spencer Ltd. filed a claim for \$4.60 against you. This claim represented an unpaid balance due on the radio. This claim has been paid.

It is felt that we have accounted for all the property of every kind left by you in the protected area, which vested in the Custodian, and, in order that you may confirm this and acknowledge the enclosed cheque, we are attaching a stamped, addressed envelope for your convenience in replying.
