Giichi MATSUBARA died at Cartierville, Quebec, on April 17, 1946. He is survived by three minor children, Tadayoshi, a son, and Yoshiko and Takako, daughters.

The deceased declared no assets to the Custodian and none appear on the file.

Claims were filed against MATSUBARA as follows:

The claims of Dr. Pedlow and Dr. Uchida were admitted by the debtor but he stated that, as he was on relief, he was unable to pay these debts. The creditors were advised accordingly. Dr. Uchida later withdrew his claim. The claims of R. Tagashira & Co. and Mrs. Michi Moriyama were denied by MATSUBARA and both were advised that the Custodian could, therefore, take no further action. The Department of Labour was advised by this office that we were not aware of any assets from which to pay their claim.
