The above person left here on June 1st for Three Valley Camp near Revelstoke. He claims he is short a No. 3 dunnage bag containing sheets, blankets and clothing. He is in great need of these articles. He apparently formerly lived at 110 Water St., but went into the Park shortly previous to his departure from here.

Our baggage man, at the Park, says that the only two bags this man brought into the Park were sent out with him.

We have traced a number of our interior housing points and have asked the C.P.R. to locate but to no avail. Possibly you could get some trace of this dunnage bag.
