

Minoru AKIYAMA is not among the owners of radios on list supplied by J. W. Kelly Piano Co. Ltd.





Confirming our conversation of this morning in connection with the above now employed at Slocan as a sheet metal worker, we have no objection to the shipment to Slocan of the following now stored at 190 West 2nd Avenue:

- 1 " 30 Foot Shoe.

We are sending this letter in triplicate in order that you may have one copy to hand to Messrs. Wilkinson as a receipt and one to send to Slocan. We understand that your Slocan Supervisor has obtained Minoru Akiyama's consent for the release of these effects.

There is just one point, and that is that Minoru Akiyama registered as having an interest in the Hardware business of Tarukichi Akiyama & Sons. We understand that this has now been liquidated but we have on file claim from the Retail Credit Grantor's Association against the latter of \$80.58. Pursuant to your instructions of the 18th ult., our representative interviewed Mr. Akiyama at the above address and completed a report on the position of his affairs. Resultant details are shown below in the order given in your instructions relative to the filing of Agents' reports.

REAL ESTATE AND PERSONAL PROPERTY

1. Location and nature of property:

Nature of realty:

The declarant advised that he does not own any real estate and so far we have not seen anything to conflict with that position.

Nature of personal property:

We have been unable to ascertain the full extent of the personal property, although Akiyama reported that he had no personal effects of value other than one 1938 Duco Radio valued at \$99.50. *Philco*

Location of Personal Property:

The radio mentioned is in storage with J.W. Kelly Piano Co., Vancouver, B.C. Location and valuation have been confirmed by that company.

2. Particulars of ownership:

T. Akiyama claims sole ownership of the property reported herein.

3. Description of land and building:

As already indicated, no real estate of any description has been revealed during our investigations.

4. Inventories:

The only item of personal property disclosed to date, is indicated under Section No. 1 above.

5. Particulars of insurance in force:

Life:

Monarch Life Insurance Co., Policy No. P88176 for \$1000. Beneficiary T. Akiyama (father) Premiums of \$47.00 per annum paid to date.

6. Particulars of liabilities:

No liabilities have been disclosed as yet, although we are endeavouring to get further information in that connection from other sources.

7. General remarks:

It has been intimated that the subject has an interest in the hardware business of T. Akiyama & Son, 368 1/2 Powell St., Vancouver, B.C. M. Akiyama claims although he is registered as a partner, by Japanese custom, his father, T. Akiyama, is considered to be sole owner.

The declarant left Vancouver on April 23rd for Greenwood, where it is understood he has obtained employment as a sheet metal worker. Since his removal we are advised the business of T. Akiyama & Son has been sold and so far as we have been able to ascertain to date there are no outstanding liabilities.


RECOMMENDATIONS
