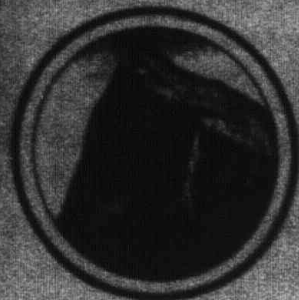

We are in receipt of a request signed by the insured and beneficiary Mrs. Sute Kondo, mother of the insured, for the cash surrender value of the above numbered policy which amounts to \$126.69.
