Re: Kiyoshi MORIMOTO, Reg. No. 05263

In regard to the copy of Summary from Vessels Records on this file, the vessel dealt with under Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee Ledger and File No. 655, was reported by the Japanese section of the Committee as the "K.M." NW.097-E, and the name of the registered and actual owner was given as Kiyoshi MORIMOTO, Steveston, B. C.

The vessel appears to have carried the identification "H.K.", NW.097-E. The naval list of impounded vessels gives the owner as K. Morimoto.

This vessel was sold to B.C. Packers Ltd. On May 29, 1942, and the Bill of Sale was signed by Unosuke SAKAMOTO, as Attorney for (Miss) Kiyoko HAMADE (Dressmaker) File 10564.

Miss Kiyoko HAMADE, on May 27, 1942, authorized that when payment was received, the monies were to be paid to Mitsujiro NOGUCHI, (File 9067), and on June 2, 1942, the net proceeds of the sale, \$492.50, were paid to that man.

The vessel file does not indicate why Miss Kiyoko HAMADE was judged to be the owner of this vessel; no licence number is given anywhere in the file.

There is nothing to show why Miss HAMADE authorized payment made to Mitsujiro NOGUCHI.

Neither Kiyoshi MORIMOTO nor Mitsujiro NOGUCHI, both of whom registered with the Custodian prior to the sale of this vessel, declared ownership of a vessel. Kiyoko HAMADE registered after the sale of the vessel.

The foregoing is intended to explain the inclusion of the copy of Vessels Summary in this file. No action need be taken by this office in regard to this matter.

Although the above named Japanese did not declare any chattels at the time of his registration with the Custodian, three fishing nets were found at the Gulf of Georgia Cannery, tagged with his name. These had been declared by his father, Mr. Seichi MORIMOTO, File 1770, now deceased. Two of the nets were sold for a total of \$23.00 and a third net was appraised by Leskie in February, 1945, and declared of no value. Since the nets had been found tagged in the son's name, the proceeds were credited to his account. He has no further chattels or personal property, so this file may now be closed as soon as we have sent him the \$23.00 in his account with us.


