


The above named Japanese certified in her declaration of April 13, 1942, that she had no property of any kind whatsoever in the protected area in British Columbia.

There are no specified articles of any kind revealed on the file.

A statement was received from the Crone Storage Company, Limited, Vancouver, on June 28, 1944, for storage charges against Miss Aiko MINAMIDE. The Custodian wrote to the Crone Storage Company on June 28, 1944, that this Japanese had no funds and suggested sending the bill direct and to advise us the results. No further word was received from Crone Storage Company but in a phone call made to them on February 11, 1946, they stated that the above goods were shipped direct on August 7, 1944.

No property interests other than those mentioned are found on the file.
