Re: Masao KOBAYAKAWA, Samuel KOBAYAKAWA
and Haruko KOBAYAKAWA, (in Japan)

We are in receipt of your letter of the 11th instant, passing on the request of the above Evacuee to have his property transferred to his brother, Samuel KOBAYAKAWA (Reg.#15366, File 3412.)

Title to the property in question is registered in the joint names of the above and his wife, Haruko KOBAYAKAWA (Enemy File #1330), who is in Japan. In accord with Sub Section 1, Section 23 of the Consolidated Regulations Respecting Trading With The Enemy (1939) a certificate has been filed in the Registry Office vesting the property in the Custodian.

In due course this parcel will be offered for sale and, if sold, proceeds will be credited to the parties entitled.

Enclosed you will find two copies of an Order-in-Council passed 24th February, 1942 (P.O. 1457) prohibiting a person of the Japanese race from acquiring lands in Canada. We suggest that one copy be forwarded to Mr. Mitchell.

As a matter of interest, we might add that the wife of Samuel KOBAYAKAWA is a Caucasian.
