Dear Sir:

In replying to your letter of August 8th regarding to the vessel "Newcastle #7" which was sold to Mr. Johnny Charlie of Tofino, B.C.

This transaction was done in November 1936 with Mr. Charlie and Mr. H. Kashino who then was a manager of Green Cove Salteries Ltd.

At that time the agreement was made that the boat was to be sold at \$700.00 which at the end of each fishing season Mr. Charlie was to pay as much till the balance was paid in full.

The agreement and the promissory note, I'm sure it is now in the safe at Green Cove Salteries Ltd. at Green Cove, B. C. where I left there last.

Regarding to the amount paid to the boat I'm not sure it was paid in full or not but you can find this if you inquire to Mr. J. Murdoch, Barrister, Solicitor, Notary Public, at Steel Building, Corner of Pender and Homer St., as he is taking care of all the company books when I left Vancouver last.

Hope that this will clear the matter of boat Newcastle #7 and Mr. Johnny J. Charisse will proceed at his fishing as season is getting rather late now.

Dear Sir:

This office has been informed that Mr. Johnny J. Charlie, of Tofino, B. C. has in his possession the vessel "Newcastle No. 7". Mr. Charlie has stated that he purchased this vessel from Mr. Kashino, of Green Cove Saltaries, in November, 1936, and that payments were made yearly at the end of the fishing season until the full purchase price had been paid.

At the present time, Mr. Charlie is unable to operate this vessel because he did not receive proper sales papers at the time of his purchase of this vessel.

We have been informed that you would be able to confirm that Mr. Charlie did purchase this vessel and that payment was made in full. If you have any information that will support the statement made by Mr. Johnny J. Charlie, we would appreciate receiving this.

Because of the lack of sales papers, Mr. Charlie has been deprived of the use of this vessel during the 1947 fishing season. This is quite a hardship if his story of the purchase of this vessel is true. Therefore if you can assist us in any way that will clear up the question of ownership of this vessel, we will be very grateful.
