Dear Madam:-

We have for acknowledgment your letter, dated the 14th of February, 1944, in reply to our letter of the 1st of February, 1944 dealing with Dr. Hori's claim of \$3.00. We note that your letter was signed by your father and that it is his desire to pay this claim from his funds. This has been noted and Dr. Hori's claim will receive attention when we make a settlement of the other claims. In the meantime, we would point out to you that as the mortgage on your father's farm requires to be paid off before any other claims can be dealt with, there will not be sufficient money left over to settle the other claims in full. However, we will write you further in this respect after the settlement has been arrived at with the Veterans' Land Act.
