

Thank you for your letter of November 11th, 1945, in reply to ours of the 26th of October, in which we stated that you owned no property in the protected area. That statement is correct according to your file.

We have reviewed the file of your wife, Tsugi MATSUBA and she declares a few articles of household goods located at Imperial Cannery House No. 20A, when she registered with the Custodian on May 18th, 1942. As none of the goods were located at the address she gave, we assume she made her own arrangements to dispose of them before she was evacuated on June 26th, 1942.
