We have on file claims against the above Japanese as follows:

all of which have been submitted to him for payment. We have written to him at Tashme, and later at Roseberry, B.C., but so far have not heard from him from either place. However, while he was at Hastings Park he admitted, by signed statement dated September 19th, 1942, that he was indebted to the Cumberland Hospital in the sum of \$42.50. This amount, however, has been increased by \$2.20 on account of Judgment obtained by the Hospital against him, making the total claim \$44.70. In the same statement he stated that he would endeavour to pay \$2.00 per month on this account. He has not made any payment to this office, and, therefore, is in arrears in this regard, say October, 1942 to and including March, 1943 in the sum of \$12.00.

We were informed by the Workmen's Compensation Board and by your office today that you were receiving \$13.30 per month from that Board on his behalf, such payment to be continued during his life-time. It was also stated that this amount was being forwarded by you to FUJIMOTO each month.

We should, therefore, be obliged if you will take this matter of claims against this Japanese up with your Supervisor in Roseberry, B.C. in an effort to secure a reply through him from FUJIMOTO.

We would suggest that the arrears of \$12.00, above noted in connection with his promise to pay \$2.00 a month, be

deducted from his next monthly cheque received by you from
the Workmen's Compensation Board, and that thereafter \$2.00
per month be deducted until the hospital account has been paid
in full.
We shall appreciate your co-operation in this matter,
and await results of your action.

We are in receipt of your letter of the 21st instant relative to the above account.

In reviewing the file it is noted that on April 6th, 1943 the Claims Department wrote to the Hospital suggesting that they get in touch with Fujimoto direct, as we had been unsuccessful in obtaining an answer from him. This letter should have gone to you, perhaps. Later on the 15th of April 1943, we took the matter of claims against Fujimoto up with the B.C. Security Commission, requesting their co-operation in obtaining an answer, as Fujimoto had not replied to any of our letters. By a letter dated 22nd April 1943 from the Commission, a copy of which we enclose to you herewith, you will see the situation at that time. The other claims against Fujimoto, lodged with the Custodian amount to \$194.16. We have not of course received any payment on the hospital account.

According to our records the present address of Fujimoto is Rosebery, B.C., and there would be no objection to your writing direct to him in the matter.
