PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

May 7, 1946.

Re: Shigeru (George) NISHIMURA, Reg. No. 07529

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 13, 1942, in which he declared that he owned no property of any kind in the protected area.

However, in a statement of Assets and Liabilities signed while he was interned on May 29, 1942, he reported fifteen \$5.00 War Saving Certificates left at Hastings Park, c/o his sister. This was later changed to twelve \$5.00 War Saving Certificates which we collected and put into our Safety Deposit Box. These were surrendered to the Registrar and on November 12, 1943 the amount of \$49.08 was remitted to NISHIMURA as their cash value.

The account of this man was credited with the sum of \$5.65 received from the Canadian Bank of Commerce as refund of part payment of Victory Bond. This amount was remitted to NISHIMURA on June 27, 1945.

The records of the R.C.M.P. showed that a radio was surrendered in the name of this man and his father. The radio was sold at auction and the net proceeds in the amount of \$86.58 were credited to a joint account. On June 27, 1945, at the request of his father, the amount of \$43.29 was transferred to NISHIMURA's account, being half the proceeds, and remitted to him.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.

On the 30th June you wrote requesting us to cash, and forward you proceeds of, your 12 War Savings Certificates.

These Certificates were forwarded to you for endorsement and were duly received back from you and forwarded to Ottawa (17/8/1943) for redemption.

Due to confusion in names arising out of the fact that all our records (your file is one of over fifteen thousand) are in the name of Shigeru NISHIMURA (without any mention of the name of "George"), whereas your Certificates, and consequently Ottawa's cheque, are in the name of Geo. NISHIMURA (without any reference to "Shigeru"), the cheque has been held for identification.

Ottawa's cheque (No. B-700979 for \$49.08, dated 25/8/1943) is now enclosed herewith—for delivery to you through the B. C. Security Commission.
