Dear Sir:

This file has been up for review and we give below a brief resume of our administration of your affairs.

On the 11th April, 1942, you signed a Custodian "No Property" card and there is no evidence in your file of any property, real or personal, left by you in the protected areas of British Columbia.

Bills Receivable: You did not declare anything under this heading but this office collected refund of wage deductions made during the period, January/June, 1941, which was credited to your account in the sum of \$6.31.

This office also collected refund of National Defense Tax, which was credited to your account in the sum of \$14.82.

Funds: The total of the above two sums (\$21.63) represents the balance of your account and as no other entries are expected therein we enclose our cheque in your favour for \$21.63, leaving no balance in your account, which will be closed.

This would appear to account for all property of every kind left by you in the protected area which vested in the Custodian, and in order that you may confirm this, we enclose a stamped addressed envelope for your convenience.
