On April 11, 1942, this man signed a declaration to the Custodian stating that he owned no property of any kind in the protected area.

However, on May 26, 1942, he sold, through the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee, the vessel "O.H." HW.2377, and on May 30th, 1942, he received the net proceeds of this sale in the amount of \$542.00.

On March 18, 1946, this office received a call from Mr. J. Lorne Pyke, Solicitor for Mrs. Ann Pottinger, Applicant for Letters of Administration in connection with the Estate of the late Alexander Pottinger. Mr. Pyke stated that the late Mr. Pottinger had given Mr. Otsiro HIRAMATSU a cheque for \$340.00 in payment for net proceeds from HIRAMATSU by Pottinger. The cheque being incorrectly signed had been returned by the bank. In order to clear this matter up Mrs. Ann Pottinger sent to this office a cheque for \$340.00, which has been credited to the account of Otsiro HIRAMATSU.
