GENERAL SUMMARY

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 3, 1942. He was evacuated on August 26, 1942. He died at St. Boniface, Man. on January 24, 1947.

In his declaration, TANABE stated that he owned no property of any kind in the protected area.

The only property in which this man might have an interest is the vessel "Minata II", which is dealt with in detail in the Vessel Summary. No other property of any kind is revealed by this file.

A claim was filed against Komataro TANABE by Hirokichi YAMANAKA, File 9085. This claim was referred to Naotio TANABE, who admitted that he was indebted to YAMANAKA in the amount of \$211.61 (which was the amount of the claim filed against Komataro TANABE) but he stated that he was unable to make settlement. This information was passed on to YAMANAKA, who was supplied with the address of the debtor. No further action was taken by the Custodian in regard to this as no funds belonging to TANABE were in Custodian Account.

VESSEL SUMMARY

File No. 3539

December 23, 1943

Re: Naotaro Komatani TANABE #01522

According to information supplied by the Canadian Fishing Company Ltd., that company advanced to "N. IZUMI", who according to information from RCMP is the same person as Naotaro TANABE, the sum of \$100.00 for the purpose of purchasing a boat. The Canadian Fishing Company Ltd. reported that IZUMI did make payment of \$100.00 on the purchase of the vessel "Hinata II". The claim filed by the Canadian Fishing Company Ltd. against TANABE is in connection with this advance.

The vessel "HINATA II" was being purchased from Masao ARIZONO, File XI.747, who has refused to supply information to this office in connection with this transaction.

The vessel "HINATA II" was reported to be at Prince Rupert at the outbreak of war with Japan. Believing her to be in Naval custody, the Canadian Fishing Company obtained from ARIZONO a Bill of Sale, and paid to the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee the remainder of the purchase price of \$325.00. The money paid to the Committee was held until the Canadian Fishing Company had taken delivery of the boat. As the Canadian Fishing Company were unable to find the vessel at Prince Rupert, the \$225.00 paid to the Committee was refunded. The Canadian Fishing Company still hold the sales papers showing the sum of \$100.00 paid to ARIZONO on the purchase price of this boat.

Among the boats taken over by the Custodian was one which carried the identification "M.A.691". It was established that these were the initials and fishing licence number of Masao ARIZONO. It was then established that Masao ARIZONO held Prince Rupert Licence No. 1211 on a vessel named "Hinata II". On the basis of this information, the "M.A.691" was sold as the "Hinata II", Prince Rupert 1211 by the Custodian for the sum of \$150.00. It is possible, however, that the vessel sold was not the "Hinata II".

If it can be established that the vessel sold by the Custodian was the same vessel that was being purchased by N. IZUMI and the Canadian Fishing Company Ltd. from Masao ARIZONO, it would be necessary to determine which of the parties interested are entitled to receive the funds now in the Custodian's hands.
