GENERAL SUMMARY

This 54-year old Painter, a Naturalized-Canadian, from Ocean Falls, B. C., signed a Custodian "No Property" card on the 3rd April, 1942. He was evacuated on the 7th April, 1942.

His wife, Stella Shida (File 10914), signed a Custodian "No Property" card on the 19th June, 1942. She was evacuated on the 17th September, 1942, presumably with her 13-year old daughter.

The following is a summary of the contents of this file as disclosed by a review made today.

Bills Receivable: Refund of 1½ wage deductions made during the period, January/June, 1941, was collected from the Provincial Collector, and credited to this account, in the sum of \$6.87, which sum was remitted (May 20/43) to evacuee.

Refund of B. C. Electric Railway Company Security Deposit (for light) was received by this office, and credited to this account, in the sum of \$1.19.

Bank Accounts: None.


Life Insurance: None.
