



Thank you very much for your letter of April 20th reporting that this individual was drowned while residing in the Three Valley work camp and that you had received a bill for his funeral.

We regret that we have no information whatsoever regarding this man's resources but our records indicate that Hifesa Shiraiishi, Registration No. 01910, reported to us on April 3rd, 1942, that he was sixty years old, was living at 757 East Hastings Street, that his wife's name is Kawanu, that he was, at the moment, unemployed, that he had been employed in the past by the B. C. Canadian Fish Company at Kitiskat, B. C., that he has no assets, that he owed \$100.00 to a Mr. Kamin of 143 Donlevy Street, that he owed \$300.00 to a Mr. Nishimura of Vancouver and that he would be unable to pay these debts because of his unemployment and, finally, that his unemployment was due to illness.

Mr. Shiraiishi also stated that he had two daughters, aged fourteen and twelve respectively, and a son nine years old.
