

SUMMARY of LIABILITIES

December 19th, 1945.

File No. 3574.

Re: Zenzo KANNO (Mr.)
Reg. No. 07420.

No claims were declared by the above Japanese person. This file, however, reveals that a claim of \$21.95 by N. Ebisusaki Company was stated by the above Evacuee's son, Tsugio Kanno, to be owed by Zenzo. On writing to the father on February 15, 1943, a reply was received under date of February 22, 1943, stating that he had "no connection or account with the Ebisusaki Company" and that the debt was owed by his son. No further action regarding this claim was taken on this file.

In January 1943 a claim against Zenzo Kanno for \$92.41 by the above Company was lodged with this office but on writing to this Evacuee no reply was received.

As the above Japanese person has no credit with the Custodian and no reply was received to our letter, no further action was taken by the Custodian and the creditor was advised to this effect on December 6, 1944.
