No Realty interest by Taneji SADA is revealed in his registration dated April 10, 1942.

Reference is made on the file to Lot 50, Block 20, District Lots 391 and 392, Plan 3047, N.W.D. and from a Tax statement indicates that Taneji SADA was the owner. However, it developed that he had given a Quit Claim deed to the Mortgagee dated December 11, 1937 "as he was unable to pay the Principal, Interest and taxes and other charges and expenses under mortgage dated 21st day of April 1930 "on this property. On account of unpaid taxes the Quit Claim Deed was not immediately registerable but was registered in December 1942.

No other reference to any assets as belonging to Taneji SADA is revealed on the file.


