Se would advise that there have been many complicated points arising from the fact that the above was unable to carry out the original arrengements, and you are doubtless owere that Mr. Messenger, of Source H. D. Compbell the here been bundling this matter, has made other arrangements with the new tements, vis. Charlie Lis and Lis Lip Foon. For your information we shouldes a copy of statement propored by Mr. Messenger, which gives in detail the final arrangements made, and from which you will see that Mr. Messate has absorbed a total loss of \$75.29 in connection with the robbery which took place at these presions while some was in the hands of a caretaker after Mr. lozavio had left. It was necessary for Mr. Messanger to put a caretaker in from the time somewho vacated, vis, the Lith of Sovember until December 10th, then the Chinemen took over. The robbery occurred during the above period and shills the corretainer was out to dinner one evening. The police of course more informed, but owing to the nature of the theft, via, tobacco, eignestics, ste., It has been impossible to recover any of the stolen stock. In view of the fact that this theft occured due to your own tenant falling down on the original arrangements made, it is only fair that you should bear a portion of the lose.
