

In reply to your letter of March 9th we have no way of checking back now to see to whom the receipt was sent although more than likely it was sent to the policyholder.

When the 1945 premium was paid we received \$7.30 more than was required and consequently we applied it to the 1946 premium.

On the 31st of January 1946 we received \$42.25 and as this overpaid the 1946 premium, by \$7.30, this overpayment was shown as a credit on account of the premium due the 1st of February 1947.

A dividend of \$11,40 was declared on the 1st of February 1947 and this was applied as a credit on account of the premium then due, and the balance of the 1947 premium was then paid on the 24th of February 1947.

As this policy stands at the present time the premiums are paid up to date, there are no arrears whatever outstanding, and the next premium of \$42.25 becomes due on the 1st of February 1952.


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
