GENERAL SUMMARY

File No. 3646

Kaichiro SAWADA, Dec'd.

Reg. No. 05039.

Kaichiro SAWADA died in Montreal, Quebec, on November 13, 1945. He is survived by his widow, Tomi, file #8885; two sons, Minoru, file #3248, and Tadashi, file #2075; and two daughters, Miyoko, file #8884, and Yoshie, file #13780.

The deceased declared no assets to the Custodian and none have come under the control of this office. The file, however reveals that the deceased sold furniture and fixtures of the Winters Hotel to James S. & W. S. Tom Lee for the sum of \$5,450.00, which was, apparently, paid direct to the deceased prior to his evacuation.

A claim for \$8.50, filed by Dr. M. Uchida, appears on this file but was later withdrawn.

On December 15, 1945, a letter was written to the widow suggesting that application be made for administration of the Estate of the deceased. No reply has been received and it is presumed that there was no estate to administer.
