MEMORANDUM

To: The File
From: Mr. Shears

Re: Seikichi KITAGAWA

Mr. Matheson of Essondale Hospital telephoned and stated that they had a sum of \$275.00 belonging to Seikichi KITAGAWA being balance of proceeds of the sale of his farm at Pitt Meadows.

Mr. Matheson also stated that the hospital had an account of \$1,600.- against this man which they were willing to waive providing the \$275.00 if sent to us would be used for this man's rehabilitation in Japan.

I advised Mr. Matheson that transportation costs were borne by the Government and that if \$275.00 was sent to us it would be handed to the Treasury and Kitagawa would receive its equivalent in Yen upon his arrival in Japan. I informed him that if the \$275.- was not turned over to us that the Dominion Government would provide this man with the basic minimum of \$200.--.

Mr. Matheson's re-action was under the circumstances that they would retain the \$275.- to apply on their own account.


Please note that the above has been repatriated to Japan. At the time of repatriation, the following transactions took place:
